Nicotine Psychopharmacology Jack E. There was some attention to the effects related to addiction, such as euphoria (Johnston 1941), tolerance (Lewin 1931), and withdrawal (Finnegan et al. 1945), but outside of research supported by the tobacco industry, addiction and psychopharmacology were not major foci for research (Slade et al. 1995; Hurt and Robertson 1998; Henningfield et al. 2006; Henningfield and Hartel 1999; Larson et al. 1961).
